

Celltech Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Conflict Minerals Compliance Statement Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, and the Securities and Exchange Commission Rules adopted in connection therewith, require certain corporations to report the use of "Conflict Minerals" in the manufacture of their products.

Generally, Conflict Minerals collectively refers to cassiterite, columbite-tantalite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, including tantalum, tin and tungsten, which originate from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or specified adjoining countries (referred to herein as "Covered Countries").

While Celltech Oy, as a privately held corporation, is not yet subject to the Conflict Minerals rules and reporting requirements, we understand that our customers may be, and we are committed to helping our customers comply with their reporting requirements.

To determine if our manufactured products contain Conflict Minerals, we have received statements or reports from our main suppliers to ascertain their use of any Conflict Minerals in the materials they supply to us. These reports and statements demonstrate that our suppliers:

(i) do not use Conflict Minerals in the materials they supply to us, or (ii) have no reason to believe the Conflict Minerals they use may have originated in the Covered Countries. Consequently, we can in turn represent that, to the best of our knowledge, our manufactured products either do not contain Conflict Minerals, or to the extent they may, such products are "DRC conflict-free" as defined by paragraph (e)(4) of Section 1502.

We will continue to work with our suppliers to ensure that we are able to identify any potential use of Conflict Minerals in our supply chain, and the representations made in this compliance statement remain accurate. To that end, we reserve the right to amend this statement at any time based on subsequent developments or information.
